Mohamed Haseeb founded UAE Legal Assist after more than ten years managing legal files inside four UAE law firms — cheque claims and payment orders, estates for Muslim and non-Muslim families, judgment enforcement, and civil and commercial disputes across the seven Emirates.

In that time the same situation came up again and again: a client abroad with a strong case, a file nobody was driving, and nobody willing to say plainly whether the matter was worth pursuing. The law was rarely the obstacle. Ownership of the file was.

He built this practice to work the other way round. He assesses every matter himself before anything is spent, prepares the filings, instructs the advocate, and reports in writing at each stage — and he stays on the file until there is a result.

That decade taught one thing above all: international clients rarely lose because the law is against them. They lose because distance, language and unfamiliar procedure let a strong case go quiet.

We exist to prevent that. Every matter is assessed honestly before anything is spent, filed correctly the first time, and reported on in writing without being chased.

OUR MISSION

To make legal action in the UAE accessible, transparent and worth pursuing for clients who are not in the country.

How we are structured

UAE Legal Assist Ltd is registered in England and Wales, company number 16624747. Contracting through a UK entity gives clients in Britain and Europe a familiar jurisdiction for their engagement terms.

We are a case management and legal support company. We are not a law firm and we do not appear before the courts. Legal representation in the UAE is provided by licensed UAE advocates instructed on your behalf, who remain the advocate of record on your file.

Four stages. One person throughout.

I Assess

We review your documents and tell you where you actually stand — including whether the matter is worth pursuing at all. Sometimes it is not, and you will hear that before you spend anything.

II Instruct

We instruct a licensed UAE advocate suited to your matter and the emirate it sits in, brief them fully, and prepare the filings ourselves.

III Manage

Hearings, expert reports, deadlines, escalation. We handle the file day to day and report to you in writing at each stage, in English.

IV Enforce

A judgment is not money. We open the execution file, attach accounts and assets, and pursue actual recovery.

The person who assesses your matter is the person who manages it.
There is no handover to someone you have never spoken to.

Three areas we do constantly. Everything else, we cover.

- Bounced cheques, including signature-discrepancy matters
- Payment orders on documented debt
- Commercial debt collection
- Execution: account attachment and travel bans

- Execution files on unenforced judgments

- Non-Muslim estates across all seven Emirates
- Transfer of company shareholdings to heirs
- Estate inventory and distribution
- Wills and estate planning for UAE assets

- Property, rental and construction disputes
- Labour, end of service and employment
- Company formation, share transfers and corporate matters
- Powers of attorney, attestation and notarisation

One person on your file

The person you first speak to prepares your case, files it and follows it through the courts. No handover. No junior you have never met.

A written cost estimate before we start

Court fees, expert fees, advocate fees and our management fee, set out before any work begins. If a cost changes, you hear it from us beforehand — not on an invoice afterwards.

Updates you do not have to chase

Written progress reports at every stage, in English, from someone in the time zone where your case is being heard.

N° 01 • NON-MUSLIM ESTATE — CLIENT IN THE UNITED KINGDOM

THE MATTER

A British national died leaving assets in more than one emirate, including shareholdings in UAE companies. The heirs were in the United Kingdom with no clear picture of what the estate contained and no way to access any of it.

THE OUTCOME

Estate traced and inventoried across all seven Emirates. Court orders obtained, company shareholdings transferred into the names of the heirs, and the estate funds distributed. Six months from instruction. No family member travelled to the UAE.

N° 02 • DISHONoured CHEQUES — CLIENT IN INDIA

THE MATTER

Several cheques from a UAE company returned unpaid. One carried a signature that did not match the account mandate — a materially different situation from an ordinary insufficient-funds cheque.

THE OUTCOME

The matters were separated by route: a criminal complaint on the signature discrepancy, execution files on the remainder. Criminal judgment obtained. Company accounts and the authorised signatory's accounts attached, and a travel ban imposed on the signatory. One month.

N° 03 • INVESTMENT FRAUD — CLIENT IN BELGIUM

THE MATTER

Funds transferred under investment contracts that proved to be fraudulent. The counterparty was in the UAE; the client was in Belgium throughout.

THE OUTCOME

Criminal complaint filed and pursued to judgment, then a civil claim founded on that ruling. Eighteen months to judgment. Enforcement of the award is ongoing.

O1 **Tell us what happened**

We instruct a licensed UAE advocate, prepare the filings and open the case. Powers of attorney are arranged so you do not need to travel.

Hearings, expert reports, deadlines and escalation, managed by us. Written updates at every stage without you asking.

O5 **Judgment and enforcement**

We open the execution file, attach accounts and assets, and pursue actual recovery — because a judgment on its own collects nothing.
